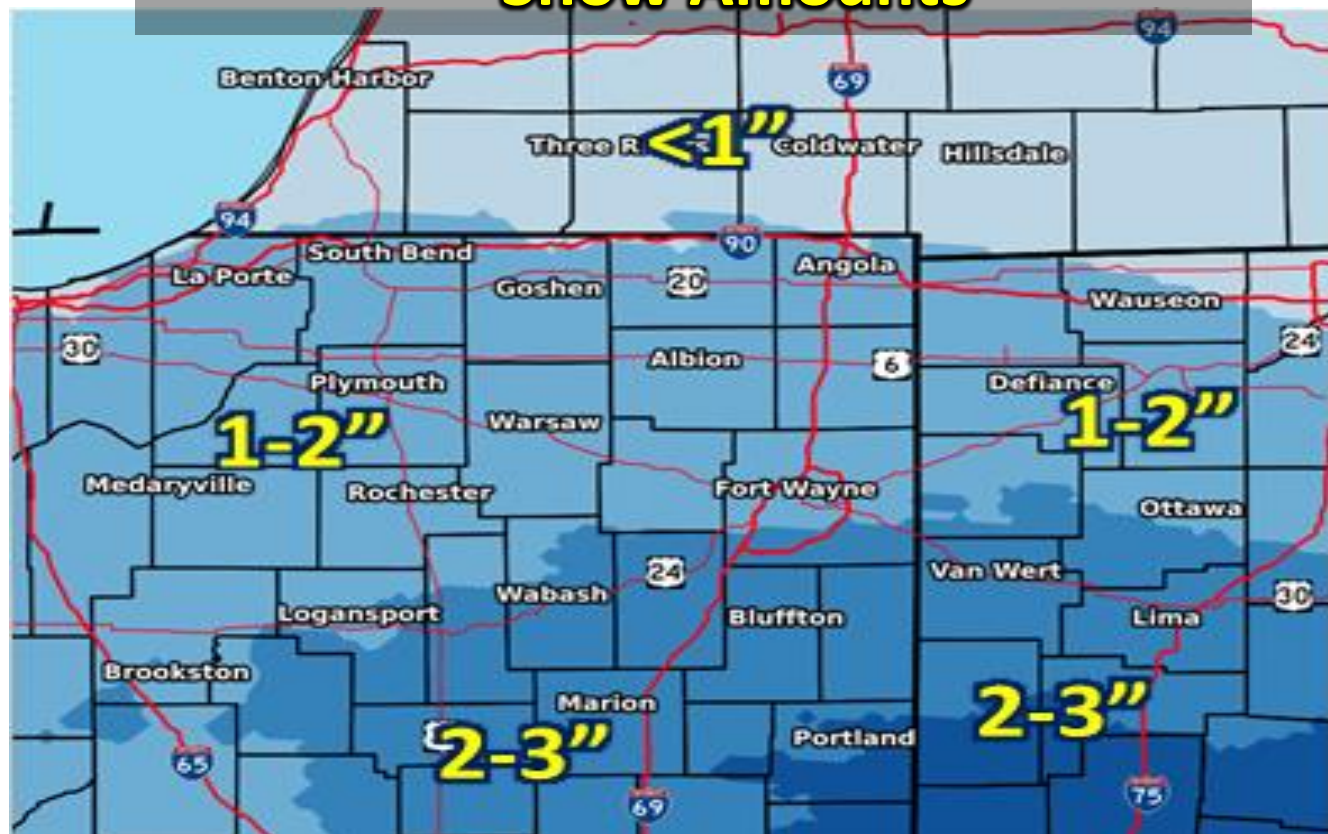


Wintry Mix Late Tonight through Wednesday

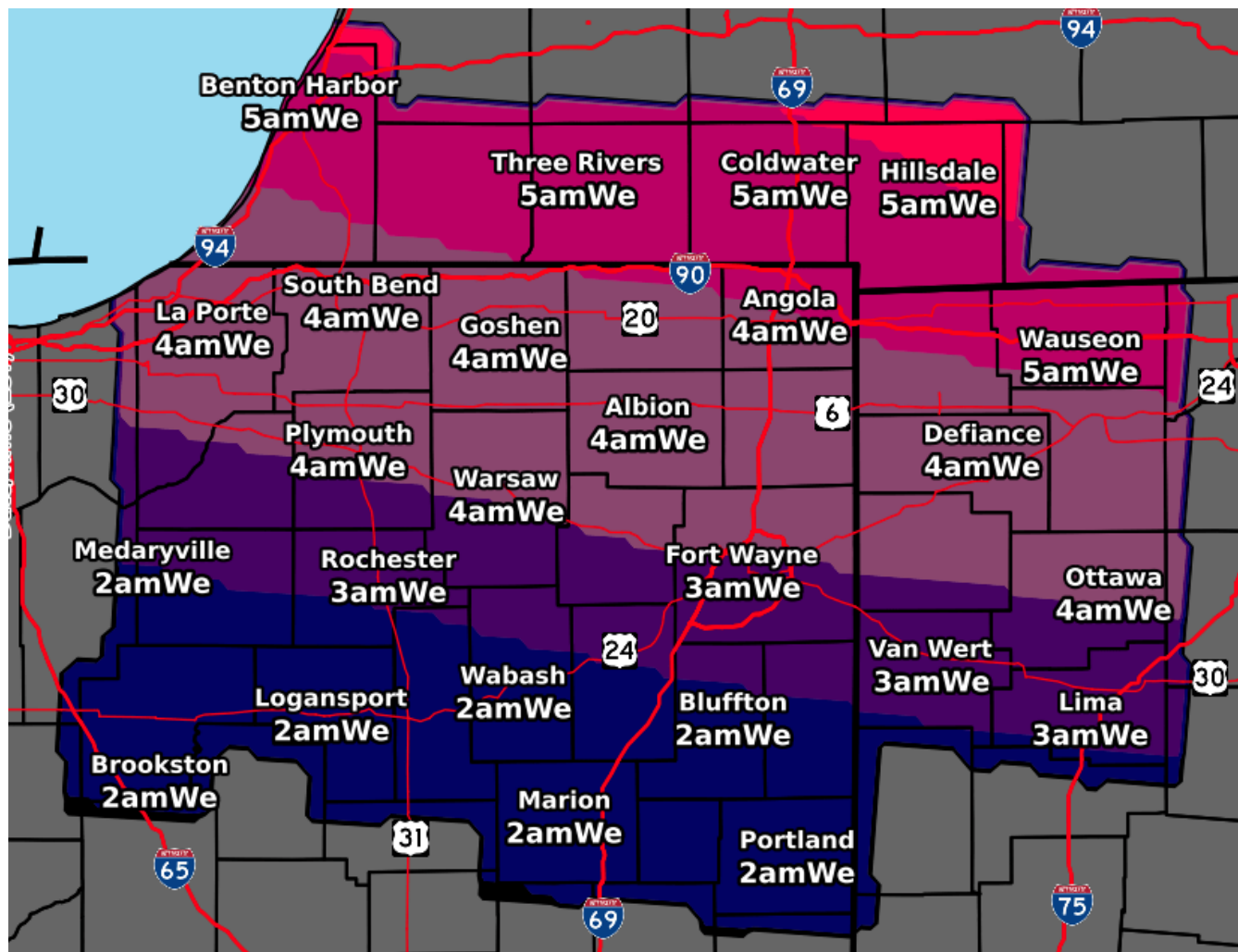
High Threat

- Snow will change to freezing rain then rain into Wednesday morning. Snow amounts are shown above with up to a 0.10" ice possible
- High confidence in occurrence of the event, but medium confidence in timing of switch to freezing rain
- Wednesday morning commute may be difficult. We will break it down more on the following pages

Additional Details

- Snow will spread from south to north late tonight as shown on the map
- Snow could be briefly heavy at times before changing over to freezing rain. Untreated roads will become snow covered.
- Confidence high in start of snowfall

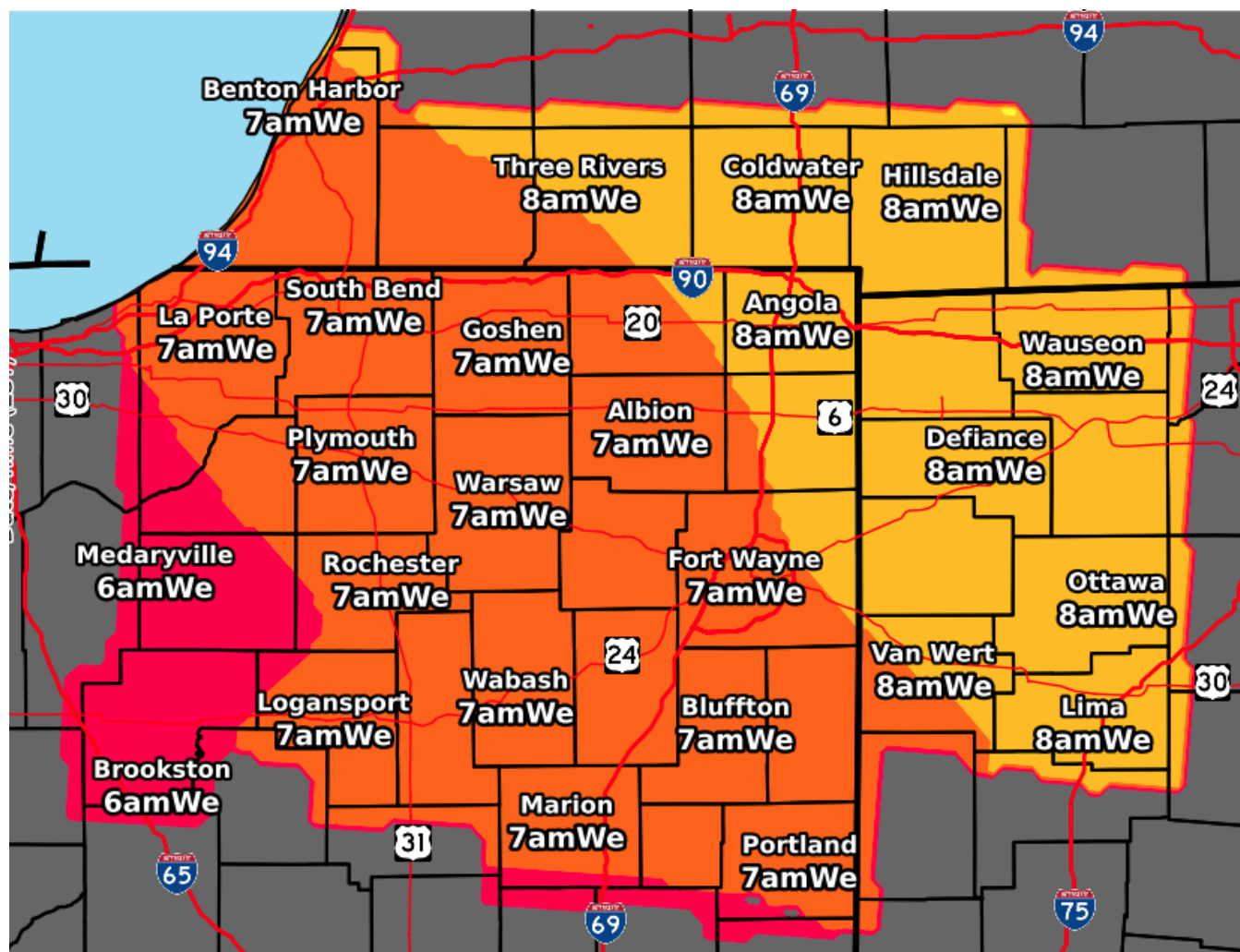

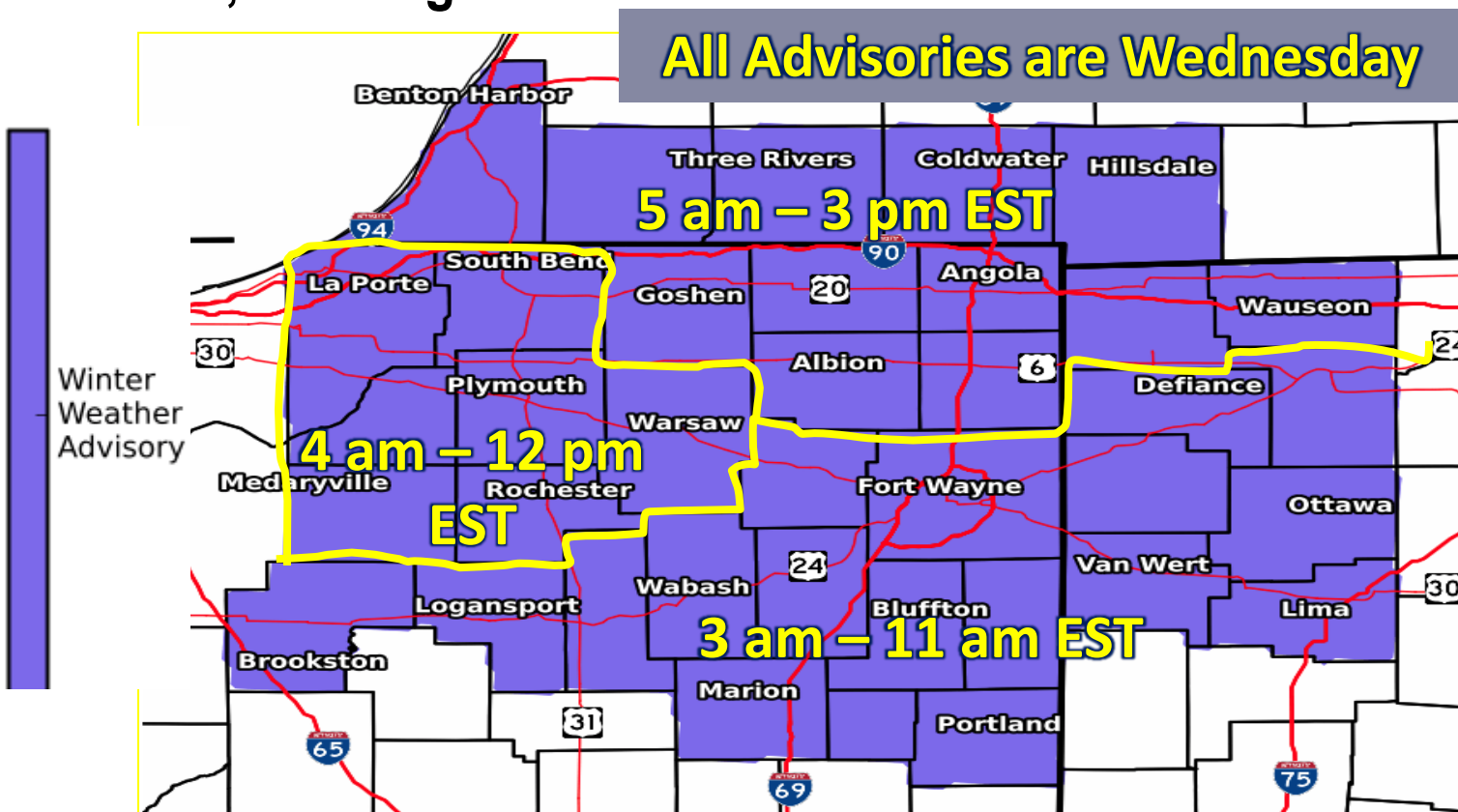
Approximate Start Time of Freezing Rain



Additional Details

- Until temperatures rise above freezing , threat for light icing will persist, which could be well into the afternoon across NE Indiana/NW Ohio/Lower MI
- For now we are focusing on start of the freezing rain as confidence is low how rapidly temperatures will rise above freezing. With a light glaze up to a tenth of an inch of ice expected everywhere.
- Winds will be from the east/southeast at 15-25 mph Wednesday morning which may help ice accrue on elevated surfaces

Winter Weather Quick Facts and Preparedness:



Quick facts you should know about winter weather:

- As little as 1/16" of ice can begin to impact roadways and sidewalks.
- 70% of snow and ice related injuries occur in automobiles. Leave extra space between you and the vehicle in front of you. Take it slow on ice and snow.

Preparedness:

- A **Winter Storm Watch** is issued when conditions are favorable for significant winter weather. *Time to prepare!*
- A **Winter Storm Warning** is issued when a combination of heavy snow, blowing snow, and possibly ice mixed with snow is expected to impact the area. *Time to act!*
- A **Winter Weather Advisory** is issued when conditions will cause travel difficulties and other minor impacts. Use caution.
